

AVDC Examination Committee (EC) COVID Protocol for Phase II Exam

Created by the Exam Committees and Board Approved 2/24/21

Pre-exam:

- Please quarantine yourself and practice responsible social distancing and mask wearing as much as possible for the week leading up to your travel for the exam.
- Optional: negative COVID test 3 days prior to travel.
- While travelling, please comply with all CDC recommendations about mask wearing.

During the Exam:

- Hotel: EC members and exam volunteers will NOT share hotel rooms. The AVDC will provide solo hotel rooms for all participants.
- EC members and exam volunteers are required to wear masks at all times while in the Oquendo Center. The only exception is for eating/drinking. Appropriate spaces with social distancing will be designated for these activities. EC members and exam volunteers must comply with Oquendo's COVID protocols at all times.
 - KN-95, N-95 or KF94 masks are preferred. The AVDC will be providing all exam team members with KN-95 masks upon arrival to the Oquendo Center. Each individual will receive 5 masks for the duration of the exam.
- Temperatures will be obtained daily. **If a team member's temperature is above 100.4 F, they will be asked to return to the hotel.**
- Exam team members will be assigned to pods, and they should limit contact with members outside their pod whenever possible.
- When together, exam team members will need to social distance whenever possible.
- When travelling in vans, masks will be worn at all times. The number of individuals within each car/van will be reduced from normal to prevent crowding.
- It is recommended that exam team members eat in their room or at designated spaces in the hotel. Please avoid eating at indoor restaurants.
- If an exam team member develops symptoms consistent with COVID during the exam or while in Las Vegas, inform the EC chair immediately. Hotel quarantine will be advised until arrangements can be made for their return home. Candidates will need to comply with all illness related airline travel requirements.

After the Exam:

In the event that an exam team member develops symptoms consistent with COVID within a week after the exam, they are required to inform the AVDC immediately by contacting Mr. Chris Daniels.
